

HEALTH UPDATE – May 2010 – Manila, Philippines

Some of you are aware of the following details; while others are not, so we ask your patience as we update everyone.

On May 6th, Eric was admitted to St Luke's Medical Centre, with fever ranging from 38-40C. After many tests and examinations, and even an "ice bath", it was determined that Eric had been attacked by two super bacteria - *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* and also by *Klebsiella pneumonia*. *Once the bacteria was identified, proper antibiotics could be administered, and this brought the fever under control. Part of the result was streph cellulitis, and this continues to be the area taking the longest to recover.*

Eric came home from the hospital on Monday May 24th, but has a long way to go on the path to recovery.

St Luke's is a world-class hospital and Eric had two Christian doctors, caring for him as well as several Christian nurses. Our SIL family has been so supportive as has been our local church family
